 - Here are the fees that are introduced anew; Dental Hygiene Lab fee, Culinary Locker fee, Skills Development & Course fee, and STCW Basic Training.
 - Here are fees that increase; Nursing materials and prep fees, SCIE Intensive English Course, Continuing Education tuitions for Self-Paced Non-Resident, Self-Prison Student, and Self-Paced International Student.
 - Here are the fees that are removed: Health and Human Application fee and Music Lab.
 - Julie asked us at Student Leadership, what would be the best way we could get the word out to students about these new fees?
 - And we talked about an open info session both online and in person with food and possible solutions to reduce the price or waver these fees.

 - The hiring process started, and the applications will be done by Thursday, April 28th.

- It has the combined jobs of the Associated Student Council and Clubs and Activities Board and there are info sessions on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday of this week.

- Interviews will be with one member of staff and two Student Leaders. And the entire hiring process will be finished by May 17th.
- The interview process needs to be run by 1 Student Leadership Staff and 2 Student Leaders.
