D. **PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD** (5 min)

- Mercer talked about issues concerning Clubs and Activities board about a Dungeons and Dragons Club and we gave him information to contact Kano or JC.
- Idaya talked about our school budgeting and where he would have to go to find the people who run the school budgeting. And he asked about the budget for the renovation of disability access in Central College. Nina suggested to talk with Dr. Johnny Wood because he oversees the department and Nina will also bring this to light in the Conversations with the President talk.
- Idaya had a second question if the Issues and Concerns committee is active or not. Sam replies of hoping to restart the committee by April 30th as the committee was of lesser usage than it should be.
- Jared talked about an all-gender restroom info session happening this Wednesday, 17th. It will be to learn about the policies and familiarize yourself with the equality of the restrooms.
