- Approve, post, and remove posters in designated campus areas
- Navigate students through basic IT related questions, accounts and passwords
- Support campus communications, student enrollment, and Welcome Week activities including providing tours of campus
- Assist prospective/new students through the enrollment process
- Attend weekly team meetings
- Maintain a clean, orderly office environment
- Support Student Leadership Front Desk operations, as needed
- Participate on student committees, student success initiatives, and special projects, as assigned

## Requirements

- Must be a currently enrolled student at Seattle Central College for Spring 2025;
- Must plan to be enrolled in at least 10 credits per quarter throughout the 2025-26 academic year (excluding Summer Quarter);
- Must be able to commit until the end of the academic year (until June 2026);
- Must have and maintain at least a 2.5 quarterly/cumulative GPA;
- Demonstrate a sincere eagerness to work with and serve students of all backgrounds and identities
  related to culture, ethnicity, religion, politics, gender, academic pursuits, and all other ways in which we
  define our uniqueness.
