1. **Health Education Center Spring Update** – Ronnie Kuan, *Executive of Administration (10* min)

Social and Human services programs are moving from the Broadway Edison building to the Pacific Tower. They represent about half of their division, which they are looking forward to. They recently held a feminine hygiene drive.
