The Center was in debt for about \$250,000 so the cuts were made.

2. **ASC Budget Update**– Jinyang Xia, Executive of Finance

Jinyang gave an overview of last year's S&A budget report. The hourly minimum wage is to increase to \$18.69 as of January 2023. Due to the minimum wage increase, the budget is affected but we are still using less of the budget than we allotted.

3. Finalizing ASC Goals – Long Hei "Ronnie" Kuan, Executive of Administration Ronnie gave an overview of 4 goals and assigned people to each goal.
Suggestions were made for connecting students to resources like tabling in satellite campuses, flyers, word of mouth and making more student involvement fairs. Heba asked for funding for graduation and parking at the hospitals for their studies.
