1. **Project Baldwin Overview** – Ebrima Banda, Project Baldwin Navigator

Ebrima described Project Baldwin; it is the umbrella program for Springboard8 sponsored by Slalom which helps a cohort of 30 black males finish their degrees.

There is also Sister Circle which is an initiative for black women at Seattle colleges. Ebrima is an alum of the program and has gotten business associates from SCC. Project Baldwin is accepting new mentors and mentees now.
