She also gave an overview of Maritime career tracks after graduation; Seaman or engineering. Questions were asked about the programs and minimum requirements for the program. The age range right now is from16-64. There are 2 simulation rooms in the building.

# December S&A Budget Update- Jinyang Xia, Executive of Finance Jinyang presented the S&A budget report. Ronnie asked about the change in EOI budget and Jinyang is to follow up. The most relevant changes were in ASC, CAB, the Art Gallery and Info Central. Info Central already used 1/3 of their
