BOARD MEETING MINUTES

A. **CALL TO ORDER** (1min)

Abuduaikeranmu called the meeting to order at 3:06 PM

B. **ROLL CALL** (1min)

C. **INTRODUCTION OF GUESTS** (1 min)

No guests present.

D. **LAND USE ACKNOWLEDGEMENT** (1min)

"I acknowledge the land on which we stand today as the traditional home of the Coast Salish people, the traditional home of all tribes and bands within the Duwamish, Suquamish, Tulalip and Muckleshoot nations. Without them, we would not have access to this gathering and to this dialogue. I ask that we take this opportunity to thank the original caretakers of this land who are still here."

E. **PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD** (5min)

There were no public comments.

F. **OLD BUSINESS** (10min)

- Mary presented updates for the ASC Associates hiring process and promotion including a recruitment video to be filmed on campus next week, flyers, emails, and a tabling event on Oct 21st and Oct 28th. There will also be promotion for hiring associates in SCC classes. Applications will be open from Oct 12th to Oct 26th. Then, there will be a deadline extension until Nov 1st. Application reviews will begin Oct 26th to Nov 2nd. Interviews will take place from Nov 3rd to Nov 15th and the final review will take place between Nov 15th to Nov 22nd. Alex requested that Mary send out the timeline to all executives and also asked for clarification on the application process itself. Mary suggested we use a Google form for students to apply for associate positions. Mary also moved to ratify the ASC hiring committee including herself, Alex, and Jaleesa. Jaleesa seconded the motion. The motion passed. Mary then motioned to approve the hiring process deadline of Nov. 1st. Alex seconded. The motion passed.

G. NEW BUSINESS (30mins)

- Jaleesa opened up discussion for ASC committee and office hour times. The Communications Committee will be meeting on Wednesdays 3-4pm. Jaleesa's public office hours will be Tuesdays (virtually) from 3-4pm and Thursdays from 1-2pm (in person). Alex informed the board that the SUB Committee has two potential meeting times/days which are Tuesdays at 3-4pm or Fridays 1-2pm. Her public office hours will be Tuesdays 1:30pm-2:30pm (virtually) and Thursdays 1-2pm (in person). Abuduakeramu informed the board that the Student Success Committee will be meeting Wednesdays from 6-7pm. His public office hours will be Tuesdays from 1-2pm and Wednesdays 1-2pm. Wendy informed the board that the Finance Committee will be meeting Tuesdays from 1-2pm. Her public office hours will be Mondays 1-2pm (virtually) and Tuesdays 10-11am (in person). Mary informed the board that the Student Advocacy Committee meetings will be Thursdays from 1-2pm. Her public office hours will be Mondays from 12-1pm and Thursdays 12-1pm. Wubwa informed the board that the Issues & Concerns Committee will be meeting Wednesdays from 2-3pm. Her public office hours will be Tuesdays 2-3pm (virtually) and Thursdays 1-2pm (in person).
- Darryl Johnson (Director of Safety and Security) presented an update on One Door Access, IDs, & Student Safety. The 1701 entrance is the one door access that all visitors, staff, and students can use if they do not have a school I.D. card. This is also where they will complete their COVID screening. If anyone needs a visitor's badge, this is also where they will take care of that. SCC lanyards are encouraged for anyone who is regularly on campus because it provides a sense of identity. There is currently security at the SAM building for students without an ID badge but they will not be stationed there for much longer (maybe just another week or two). We should also make sure we are closing all campus doors behind ourselves to prevent any intruders. There will be an earthquake drill on October 23rd to prepare for potential evacuations. Also, everyone on campus should be mindful of the fact that it is getting darker and therefore potentially more dangerous after hours in the neighborhood.
