Dr. Shella gave a very positive feedback and mentioned the house bill that passed in the legislature 2021 regular session, relating to the menstrual hygiene products in the school and the post-secondary institution bathroom. The bill requires school districts and private schools to make menstrual hygiene products available at no cost in all gender-neutral bathrooms. Also, restrooms must be designated for female students located in schools that serve students in grades six through twelve, beginning in the 2022-23 school year.
