E. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES** (1 min)

G. OLD BUSINESS (5 min)

1. Discussion of 2022-2023 Student Fee Changes – Wendy Bu – Executive of Finance (5 mins):

Wendy shared the SCC request for the new FY 2022-20223. She shared details for each item in the document list. There were no questions, comments, or concerns.

H. NEW BUSINESS (60 mins)

1. College Updates & Student Advisory Discussion – Dr. Yoshiko Harden – Interim President, Seattle Central College (20 mins):

Student advisory council discussion with Alex. She is working on projects which the previous presidents were working on, and the focus is to connect student voices. There was a question from Mary about the specific duties the student council and college council will be assigned. President shared that it is about shared concerns and ideas and not any specific duties. President shared that the very basic purpose is to bridge the communication gap between different councils and clubs etc. The advice is to come from both the President and the council as well. Taryn asked a question as to if the council is formed then will it include Satellite campuses and the president said yes if the council was to be formed it will include all the campuses related to Seattle central. The president also included comments about the masking, and she added there is still confusion, and the final decision is still not decided. There was a quick introduction from the ASC council for the president.

2. President's Medal Committee and Updates – Ecko Abulikemu – Executive of Student Success (10 mins):

Ecko shared that the President's medal committee will be opened on March 28, Application review will take place on April 29. May 31 the event will take place. Ecko is working on the recruitment of more members.

3. **Approval of Constitution Review / Revision** – Tai Lee & Mary Nguyen – *ASC Associate & Executive of Legislation Affairs. (10 mins):*

Tai shared a document that showed the bylaw changes that were to be made. He specifically talks about a few important changes. The article, the section was shared and the reason why the change is being implemented was highlighted. Most of the highlighted changes were from Article VI, Section IV, and point G (General Executive Duties). There was a discussion on keeping the tabling or removing it. The council agreed on keeping the tabling. For the rest of the two items, there was a vote, and they were removed.
