D. **LAND USE AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT** (1 min)

“I acknowledge the land on which we stand today as the traditional home of the Coast Salish people, the traditional home of all tribes and bands within the Duwamish, Suquamish, Tulalip, and Muckleshoot nations. Without them, we would not have access to this gathering and this dialogue. I ask that we take this opportunity to thank the original caretakers of this land who are still here.”

E. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES** (2 min)

Approval of minutes from December. 13, 2021, ASC regular meeting (Approved). Mary passed a motion to approve the minutes from December 18, Alessandra second the motion. The motion passed.

F. **PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD** (5 min)

Paul Peterson made a comment that this is his first experience in the student council, and he is looking forward to working for the Wood tech center.

G. **OLD BUSINESS** (5 min)

1. **Legislative Session Preparation Update** – Mary Nguyen – *Executive of Legislation Affairs* (10 mins):

Mary gave an update on legislation. A meeting with Senators is being set up to talk about the legislative priorities. Mary represented a document that reflected upon the three legislative priorities for this year. Mental health resources, campus food insecurity, and textbook affordability. Mary passed a motion to approve the legislative priorities. Ahmed Abbasi seconds the motion. The motion was approved with a vote.

H. **NEW BUSINESS** (60 mins)

1. **January S&A Monthly Budget Update** – Wendy Bu—*Executive of Finance* (10mins)

Wendy presented the updated budget document. She mentioned ASC book fund YTD balance is very low. She is planning to increase it, but it is yet not decided.

2. **Discussion on Needs/Duties of New ASC Associates** – Alex Roque - *Executive of Administration* (10mins)

Alex highlighted the ASC council was down on members, but three associates joined last year. She called out to the other members for open discussion about who does the council needs to progress with their goals. Most of the council members agreed that hiring new people is helpful but not a necessity. Wendy also shared a document representing the total number of hours for both Executives (14 hours) and for the associates (12 hours). The hourly rate has been increased to \$17.29. Wendy passed a motion to increase the hours for executives

to 14 hours per week and increase of 12 hours per week for Associates. Ecko second the motion and the motion was passed with majority of votes.

3. **Approval for Updated ASC Budget** – Wendy Bu - *Executive of Finance*
(10 mins)

Alex also moved a motion to extend the meeting to 10 mins. Ecko second the motion and the motion passed with votes. Wendy shared an informative document representing the hours and rates for the ASC council. The minimum wage increased \$16.39 to \$17.29.
